Method:




1. Cut the peg board and plastic panel to fit inside your Z Rack dimensions.
2. Line up the peg board with the plastic panel and drill matching holes through the peg holes into the plastic panel. The holes should be drilled along the top and the two sides of the boards. Ensure that there is a supporting hole in each corner.



3. Paint the plastic panel with the Dry Erase Paint to create a white board. This additional coat will help to prevent premature ghosting. Follow the manufacturer's instructions on the paint packaging.

4. Place the peg board and painted plastic panel back-to-back and thread zip ties through both boards.




5. Hang the top of the boards to the top of the Z Rack using zip ties. Only tighten the zip ties once all the ties are attached and the holes are properly aligned.



6. Cut off the excess part of the zip ties.



7. Mount the newsprint roll of paper to the peg board side of the ideation board:
 - i. Drill two holes in the end of the metal pipe and fit each side with a screw and two wing nuts to prevent the paper from sliding off the pipe.



- ii. Rest the metal pipe on two large peg board hooks.



- iii. Drill an additional hole in the opposite end of the metal ruler.

- iv. Use two wing nuts to attach the metal ruler to the peg board below the metal pipe so that the newsprint paper rolls underneath it.




- v. Place the roll onto the metal pipe, then place the pipe on the hooks. Thread the paper down behind the ruler.

You can use the ruler as a paper cutter to easily tear the newsprint at selected intervals.




- 8. Place hooks and baskets on the peg board as desired. Feel free to experiment with various combinations to suit your needs and purposes.


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9. Using a level, cut and place magnetic strips on the white board side of your ideation board.



10. Place two large clips on the top of the ideation board. These can be used to display graphics or hold the newsprint in place while you ideate.



11. Zip tie down both sides, connecting the peg board and painted plastic panel to the Z Rack.
12. Tighten the zip ties only once all are placed and the holes are correctly aligned.
13. Cut off the excess part of the zip ties.

14. Stock your Ideation Board with a variety of supplies you may need.
